

## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS (FAQS)

Q: What is the SWDC Community Center?

A: The SWDC Community Center is a planned 6,000 SF space that will serve as a vibrant, central hub for the Southwest and Navy Yard neighborhoods that provides an inclusive space for a wide range of services and activities that foster personal and collective growth.

Q: Where will the SWDC Community Center be built?

A: The SWDC Community Center will be located on the first and second floor of 375 M Street SW, a to-be-built multifamily apartment building next to the Waterfront Metro station.

Q: When will the SWDC Community Center open?

A: The earliest the Community Center will be operational is 2027. The exact timing will depend on when 375 M Street SW receives all its approvals and starts construction.

Q: What kind of programming will be at the SWDC Community Center?

A: The programming has not been determined yet. We are gathering feedback from the community so we can get a better sense of what programming should be offered at the Center.

Q: Who will operate the SWDC Community Center?

A: The SWDC Community Center is a 501(c)3 non-profit organization. The Center will likely be staffed with paid employees but volunteers will also be accepted and appreciated.

Q: How can I get involved?
